Dates and Deadlines

Semester Dates

Fall Semester 2018:

1st day of classes: August 20th

Last day of finals: December 14th

Spring Semester 2019:

1st day of classes: January 7th

Last day of finals: May 3rd

Semester Application Periods:

❖ Fall 2018 & AY18/19: Jan. 1st – April 1st

❖ Spring 2019: Aug. 1st – Oct. 1st

Arrival on Campus

- Accepted students typically begin to arrive at Georgia Tech the Wednesday or Thursday before classes begin.



Application Instructions

Exchange partners must first confirm how many spots are available for the upcoming semester before nominating a student(s).

After confirming spots, please complete the Online Nomination Form.

You will be asked to submit the following:

- Name
- Date of Birth & Gender
- Program of Study
- Level of Study (Bachelor's, Master's)
- Emailaddress

Application Instructions cont.

The Exchange Application consists of 3 parts. All application items must be received by the appropriate deadline.

1.

OIE Application Instruction Email -

Students will receive an email from OIE with specific instructions on the application process, and items required for the J-1 DS-2019.

2.

GT Transient Student Application Submitted Online- this link will be sent directly to the nominee.

3.

Original Documents- Must be sent by post, with tracking information, to OIE:

- Official Transcript (in English)
- GT Non-Degree Applicant Form (oie.gatech.edu/exchange)
- Language Certification (if applicable)
 - TOEFL iBT 95 or IELTS 7.0
- Portfolio (Arch and Ind. Design only) – *electronic preferred*
- **GRE/GMAT (required for Grad students)**



Immigration Documents

Once accepted into the Exchange Program, Georgia Tech will mail the DS-2019 and Acceptance letter to the address indicated in the Nomination form.

Student must then:

- Pay I-901 SEVIS fee at fmjfee.com
- Apply for a J-1 Visa
 - Please visit travel.state.gov and j1visa.state.gov for visa application information

Please note: Visas can take several weeks to process. Students should apply for the J-1 Visa as soon as possible.

When traveling to the United States, student's passport must be valid at least 6 months into the future.



Housing

Exchange students have the following housing options:

- I-House- Georgia Tech's international-themed dorm

 - Students should apply *before* admittance to Tech.
 - Available to any undergraduate exchange student.
- Other On-Campus housing
 - Fall or Spring semester students email incomingexchange@oie.gatech.edu for options.
 - Full Academic Year students apply at housing.gatech.edu after admission to Georgia Tech
- Off-Campus Housing
