Accommodation

Host Family program

What is included? A fully furnished room and 3 meals a day.

Cost: \$400 USD

Off-Campus accommodation

We do not have residence halls, but we provide a list of options around campus. All arrangements must be handled by the students.

What is included? Please review with the landlords

Cost: Between \$200 and \$500 USD



Living expenses

- ★ Accommodation.....\$200 to \$500 USD per month
- ★ Meals.....\$5 USD per meal (Cafeteria)
- ★ Transportation (cabs).....\$5 USD per 20 minutes ride in a cab
- ★ Transportation (public).....\$0.50 USD buses, subway, light train
- ★ Copies.....\$0.10 USD (black and white)
- ★ School supplies.....\$50 USD per course per semester



Migration Process

The migration process is defined by the nationality of the students:

- ★ Free nationalities do not need a visa if they are staying for 180 days or less.
- ★ Restricted nationalities require a visa, regardless of the time of stay.

Everyone coming to Mexico for more than 180 days, needs a visa.
