Nomination and application process

Nomination and application deadlines

For study in semester 2, 2018

Nomination deadline: 15 April 2018Application deadline: 30 April 2018

For study in semester 1, 2019

Nomination deadline: 15 November 2018Application deadline: 30 November 2018

Nominate your students: We'll send you our nomination link when applications open.

Application details

Within one week of their nomination, students will be emailed with further application instructions. The following document will be required:

- Academic transcript colour copy of front and back with English translation (if necessary)
- Proof of their English Proficiency (if necessary)
- List of preferred units of study
- Portfolios (Architecture only)



Application lifecycle

- 1. Nomination received
- 2. Application instructions sent to student (within one week of nomination)
- 3. Application submitted online by student
- 4. Application processed by University of Sydney (within one week from application submission)
- 5. Offer made through Sydney Student Portal
- 6. Student accepts offer and pays for OSHC
- 7. Acceptance and payment processed by University of Sydney
- 8. Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) issued to student (within one week of payment)
- 9. Student applies for relevant visa
- Enrolment made available to student prior to arrival



Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) Purchasing OSHC is a mandatory requirement of the Subclass 500 Student Visa. Most students purchase their OSHC through us, which we organise with Allianz, who have an assistance counter on campus. More information: sydney.edu.au/study/oshc
