- **Minimum course load** = 12 UMN credits
- **Maximum course load** = 20 UMN credits
- **3000, 4000, 5000** courses are undergraduate courses available to bachelor's and master's exchange students
- **6000+** courses are graduate courses and are available to master's exchange students only

Business and non-business courses are available to exchange students. Students will complete a course preference form before arrival and official registration will take place during the mandatory Welcome Program.

Arrival & Student Visa
