	The cost of housing ranges from 55,000 to 90,000 yen per month.	
	Although the School of Commerce office will offer necessary information, it is student's

Facilities	On the day of entrance to Waseda (April 1 st for Spring and September 20 th for Fall), each	
	exchange student will receive a student ID card. With this ID card, the student can access
